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The Past - A Key to the Future

The Neve Amiel Youth Village is creating a Culture and Family Reception Center as a central heritage and entrepreneurial site for our village. The Center will be constructed as a replica Ethiopian Village, a testament to the close relationship Neve Amiel has had over the years with Ethiopian youth. The Center will provide a space for family intake, seminars and Shabbatons, housing a permanent exhibit that celebrates the diversity and multicultural experience of the Village and the Youth Aliyah movement. The Center will also serve as a platform for small business entrepreneurship including hosting overnight corporate retreats, leadership and survival workshops, tour groups, a multiethnic restaurant, and gift shop of handmade goods crafted by our youth. The business platform will provide vital internship and salaried opportunities for our youth through our professional certification tracks in hotelier (chef), horseback, cycling and survival instructors.

Our plan includes construction of new and renovation of existing structures to include the large reception, conference and exhibition hall, and three smaller Ethiopian style huts (Gojos or Tukles) that can provide overnight lodging for up to 15 guests, serve as unique dining niches, workshop spaces and which will display student projects and commemorate our alumni accomplishments.
